Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order (Footpaths and Bridleways in Grizedale Forest, Broughton Moor, Whinlatter Forest and Wythop Woods)

The Malcolm Wilson Rally will take place on Saturday 14 March 2020, one of two major rallies taking place in these forests each year.

As you may be aware, some of the rally's "off-road" sections cross or follow public footpaths or bridleways. The Malcolm Wilson Rally's route will affect rights of way in Whinlatter Forest, Wythop Woods and Grizedale Forest.

In November last year I forwarded a copy of a closure order notice covering the affected routes. The order is still in force and we intend to implement it on 14 March 2020 for one day. This means that the public rights of way affected will be closed for the day of the Rally but will be opened again as usual after it has finished.

I attach a copy of the notice and the plans relating to this order. If you have any queries or concerns in the meantime, please let me know.
